REAFFIRMATION OF SISTER SCHOOL RELATIONSHIP

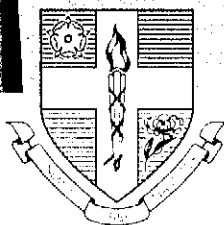
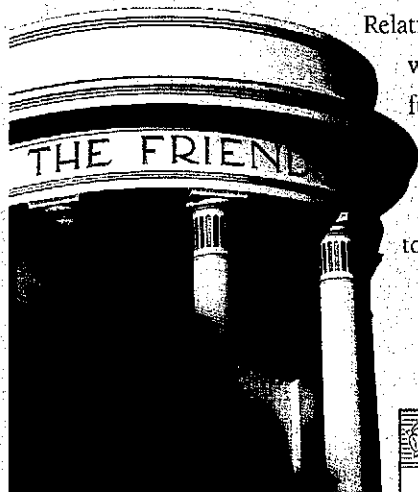
KOCHI NISHI SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL – THE FRIENDS' SCHOOL






