



Yuko: Right. But there are many school events in fall, so students are very busy. They have no time to read.


Jim: I see. Oh, there is another interesting thing. The largest number of students came to our school library in winter. About five hundred students visited our library in February.


Yuko: That's right. But they didn't borrow many books. They borrowed only seventy-five books.


Jim: Oh! I get it. Many third-year students came to our library during the winter because they studied at our library for their entrance exams.



Her name is Lisa. She came to Japan when she was a student. She was interested in Japanese traditional art like *ukiyo-e*. She studied art in Kyoto for two years. After she went back to the U.K., she started working at a museum in London. There is some Japanese art in the museum she is working at. A special exhibition about Japanese art is held there every year.

Lisa really loves Japan. She has been there many times, but she has never been to Shikoku. So I told her about Kochi. For example, we have good food, a big Sunday market, an old castle and beautiful rivers. She enjoyed listening to me. She is very interested in eating good food in Kochi.
