Ms. Green : Of course.

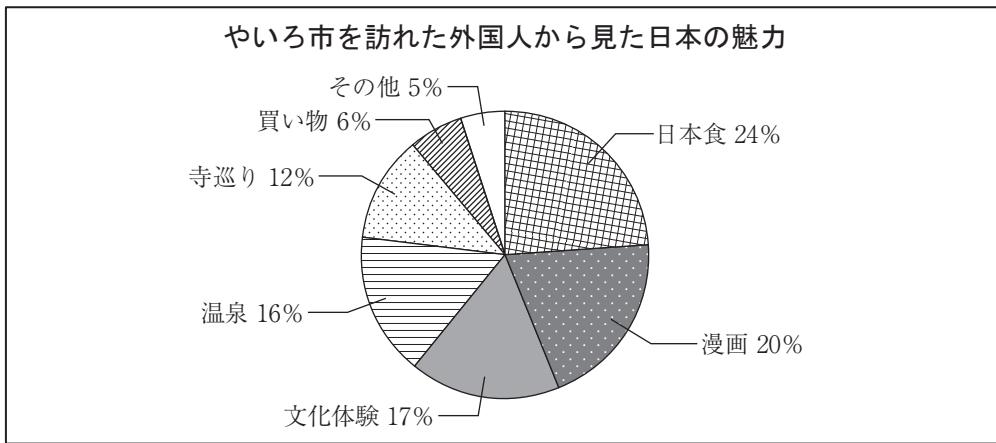
Koharu : 12% of people chose visiting temples as Japan’s main attraction.

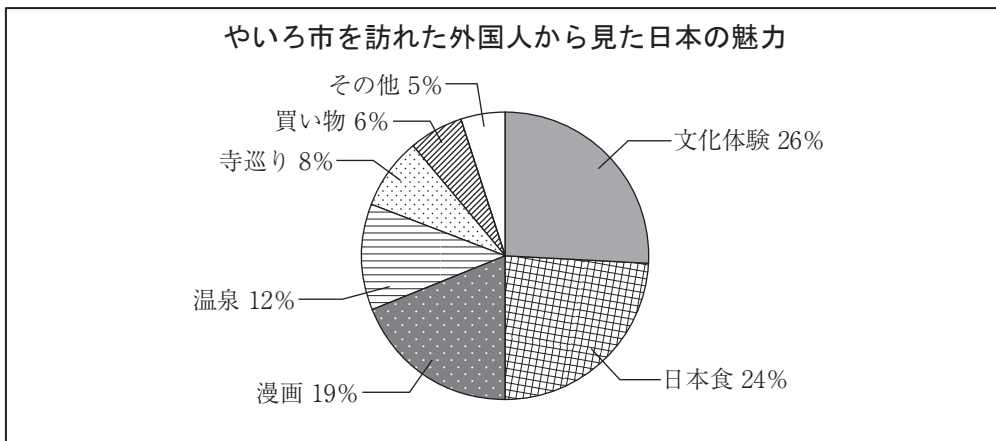
Koharu : You’ve tried many things in Japan! Experiencing Japanese culture like tea ceremony and wearing a *kimono* was the most popular among foreign visitors.

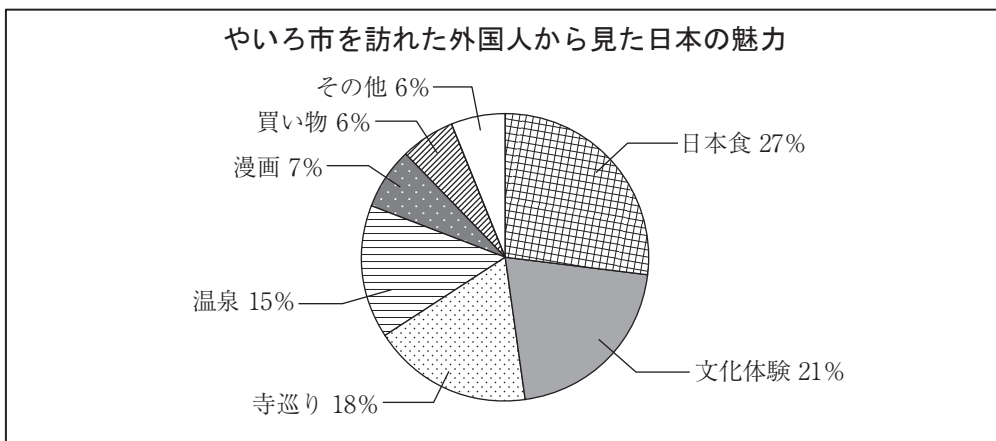

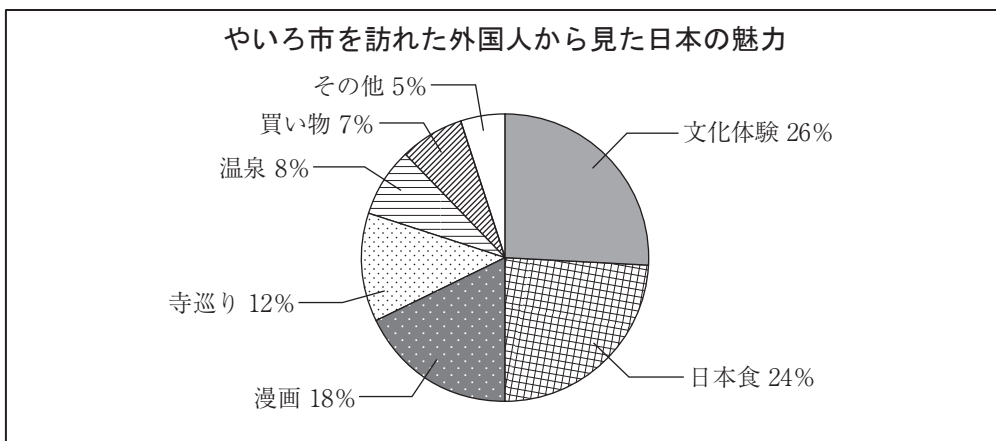
